Rutgers University School of Law-Camden, Office of Career Planning and Professional Development and the Office of Pro Bono and Public Interest programs are co-hosting a Public Interest & Public Service Symposium at the law school on Saturday, October 18, 2008 from 9:00 am to 1:30 pm.

The symposium is designed to provide information to students and attorneys who are interested in pursuing or furthering a legal career in the area of public interest and public service. The program will begin with a plenary session entitled, "CIVIL GIDEON: A Right To Counsel in Civil Cases" and will include approximately ten workshops on topics such as: Consumer Law, Children and the Law, Criminal Defense, Criminal Prosecution, Immigration, Education Law, Disabilities and Civil Rights. In addition a workshop on How to Get a Public Interest/Public Service Job will also be offered.
