To be eligible for enrollment in the Child and Family Advocacy Clinic (CFAC), students must complete this form and return it to Mary Ann Purvenas in the Clinic Office by Friday, April 1, 2011.

Students who wish to enroll in the CFAC must also ideally be able to attend a training session(s) prior to the beginning of the semester. The date will likely be August 22, 2011 but will be officially set once the course roster is finalized considering everyone's availability. If attendance at the session is not possible, the professor may be able to make other arrangements.<sup>1</sup>
